# Where We Are



## Shenzhen, Guangdong

Shenzhen, adjacent with Hong Kong, is located in the east coast of Pearl River Delta. The Special Economic Zone has created an economic miracle in China, growing from a small fishing village to a prosperous modern city over the past 40 years. Shenzhen is a major financial centre in southern China. The GDP in Shenzhen hit 1.95 trillion yuan (\$284 billion) in 2016, year-on-year rises of 9%, ranking fourth, after Shanghai, Beijing and Guangzhou, among mainland cities. It is home to the Shenzhen Stock Exchange as well as the headquarters of numerous home grown multinational companies such as Tencent, ZTE, Huawei, DJI, BYD, Vanke, JXD, Hytera, CIMC, Hasee and China Merchants Bank.

\* Standard single room is limited in quantity and the accommodation is subject to availability.



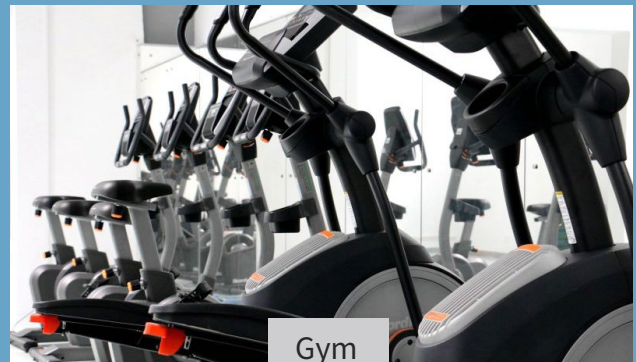

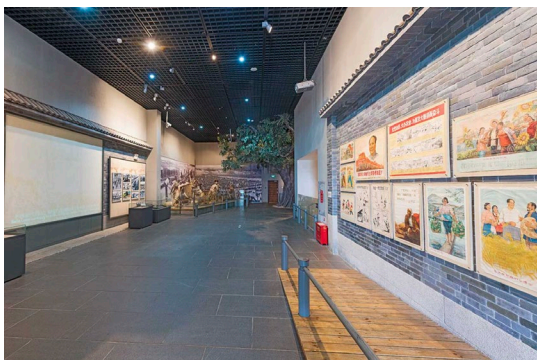

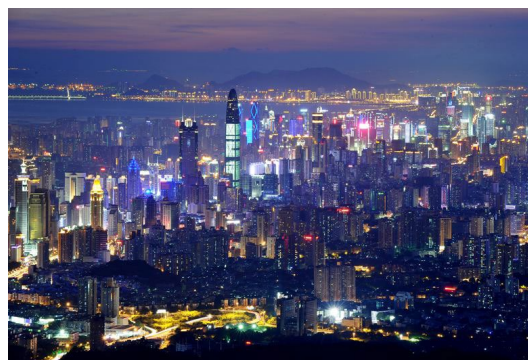
ISP puts emphasis on experiential learning by combining classroom teaching with field studies.

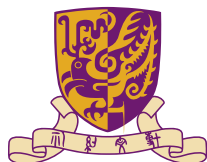
